

## **ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14**

## TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF D5021 NUTHURST ROAD AND TEMPORARY SPEED RESTRICTION A3400 LIVERIDGE HILL & A3400 BIRMINGHAM ROAD, HENLEY IN ARDEN

Warwickshire County Council **proposes to make** Temporary Traffic Orders details as indicated below:

Effects of Orders	D5021 Nuthurst Road closed to vehicular traffic at its junction with Liveridge Hill, there will be no access from or egress to Liveridge Hill. Access to Nuthurst Road from Mows Hill Road will be for residents/businesses only.
	A 10 mph speed restriction will be imposed through the convoy working area for the safety of all road users and of the contractors working in the carriageway, traffic will be managed through the works to allow convoy working.
	A 40 mph speed restriction will be imposed on A3400 Birmingham Road and A3400 Liveridge Hill for the safety of all road users until resurfacing of the carriageway is completed.
Reason for Orders	To safely facilitate carriageway resurfacing and associated works.
Order Effective from: 19 January 2020 for up to 18 months.	

Anticipated Completion Date: 29 January 2020.
