<u>WHEREAS</u> the Warwickshire County Council ("the Council") as traffic authority for A3400 Liveridge Hill & A3400 Birmingham Road, Henley in Arden is satisfied that the speed of traffic on the said road should be restricted by virtue of works proposed to be executed thereon

<u>NOW THEREFORE</u> the Council in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. This order shall come into operation on 19 January 2020 and may be cited as "The Warwickshire County Council (A3400 Liveridge Hill & A3400 Birmingham Road, Henley in Arden) (Temporary 40 Mph Speed Restriction) Order 2020".
- 2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on A3400 Liveridge Hill & A3400 Birmingham Road, Henley in Arden for a period of 18 months commencing on 19 January 2020, or until the said works are completed, whichever is the earlier.
- 4. The provisions of Article 2 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs, as authorised by Section 64 of the said Act of 1984.
- 5. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling with regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
