

Planning report January 2021

The last meeting of the year was held on 15th December with five applications, two of which concerned our two junior schools which are both expanding.

One other application was retrospective. It is important that the public is aware that Planning Permission may be required especially in the Conservation Area. A call To Stratford DC will usually confirm whether permission is needed.

Since the last meeting we have had to call in Mousley Tree Surgeons to prune back a dangerous tree overhanging the footpath behind the C of E Primary School. He was able to obtain a Dangerous Tree Order which does not require the Conservation Area Notification for tree works /TPO application process. We were grateful for his prompt action.

So far this year we have had no new applications!
