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TERMS & CONDITIONS

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1. Payment

Payment is Due within 30 days of Invoice date; new customers may need to pay via Proforma. We do not accept retention or mcd on our invoices.

2. Minimum Charge

Our minimum charge is £495exVAT unless otherwise stated

3. Cancellation of Works

Cancellation of scheduled works within 24 hours will result in a minimum charge being applied. Cancellations on site will result in 100% of the works being applied

4. Waiting or non-productive time

(excluding that resulting from adverse weather conditions) will be charged at the hourly cost of labour, plant & loss of productivity. Current rate is £200 per hour / part-hour, per team and vehicle. This would be applicable to site inductions.

5. Out of hours works

or weekend works will incur an additional 20% / 25% respectively unless otherwise agreed or stated on the quotation. Our standard working hours are 08.00 to 17:00 Monday – Friday.

6. Setting out of works

The client or elected site contact shall be responsible for the setting out of works, or for overseeing and confirming the correct setting out of works by our personnel. Any errors in setting out shall subsequently be the responsibility of the client.

7. Additional Works

Unless otherwise stated the elected site contact has the authorisation to instruct additional works.

8. Site Cleaning Preparation For lining

The client is responsible for ensuring the site is free from obstruction and in a suitable condition (free from moss/mud/high quantities of dust). If our operative are to prepare the surface this will be charged as non-productive time unless prior agreement has been made.

9. Traffic Management

Is not included unless otherwise stated

10. Responsibility for Defects

will only be acknowledged for defects in materials/workmanship which arise only after the completion of works.

11. Works on to Block Paving

Thermoplastic/Tack Coat/Chlorinated Rubber markings tend to wear out quicker due to the abrasive qualities of the blocks and the sand in the gaps as a result these works cannot be guaranteed.

12. Markings to Smooth Concrete & Power Floated Surface

Curing agent must be advised before works commence as many have to be removed by mechanical/chemical abrasion. If the concrete is found to have a curing agent and the contractor has not been advised prior no warranty will be in place

13. Colour Stability

of marking materials cannot be guaranteed as it is dependant on location & environmental conditions. Lines will become dirty when used internally & require routine cleaning.

14. Purchase Orders

These terms and conditions supersede any conflicting terms in purchase orders unless pre agreed in writing.
