Pandemic

123 + Bin System

System has gone live

When SDC introduces a new waste system and are co-ordinating 131,000 households and 42 collection rounds there will always be a few teething issues. This scheme is not unique to SDC & WDC – it is being rolled out nationally. This scheme makes a big difference in our attempts to achieve Carbon Neutral status by 2030. I would like to remind you why we are doing this – there is a climate emergency and we are trying to save the planet for future generations.

Maggots in the bins

This is not new! Previously when you put food waste in your Black / Grey bins it was easier for flies to get in and lay maggots – you probably just couldn't see them!

You can lock your food caddies by bringing the handle from the back to the front – this makes it harder for flies to get in plus stops other animals getting into them.

If you do find lots of maggots – boil your kettle and pour some into the caddie and swill round – this kills them.

SDC APP

For those of you who use Smartphones or computers - Download the SDC app from www.stratford.gov.uk/app or by searching the App Store or Google Play.

This will give you advice when your bins are to be collected and also send you a reminder.

Do you know someone with no access to modern communications?

If you want to score some 'good Karma' points check with your neighbours – if they don't have a computer or smart phone then you can always look up their address on your phone and make them aware of it.

Go into your app – click on change setting > address and put in their address. If you mess this up go back to Settings > go down to the bottom in General and 'Reset App Data' and you can put your details back in.

If their collection day is the same as yours – knock on their door and remind them when you put your bins out. Be a good neighbour.

If you meet a residents who is a bit unsure of Apps you can also help them and set it up for them! I have done this a number of times last week, this is easy to do and goes down well. Again, if you are struggling get in touch with me and I will go round and set it up for them.

No Food Caddie?

Options:

- 1) Report it via phone, App or Email.
- 2) Contact me I have distributed lots over the last week it normally takes me a few days to get them from Biffa and drop them round. If you know of anyone who has not received a food caddie please ask them to get in touch with me.
