He has also been the driving force in establishing many charities, including **The Prince's Trust** & **The Prince's Foundation**.

Warwickshire has played a major role in the history of our Monarchy from the time of Richard Neville, the 16^{th} Earl of Warwick and I know we will celebrate the Coronation of our King and Queen Consort on May 6^{th} in many diverse and fitting ways, and I want to thank you for your part in this historic occasion.
