Alcester Police SNTs. Latest Weekly Report. Sunday 23rd April 2023

Based at Alcester Police Station, The Safer Neighbourhood team’s primary roles are around crime prevention, problem solving both long standing or emerging issues of community concern and community engagement. We are supported at Alcester by colleagues from Patrol teams whose role is to respond to incidents and investigate crimes that occur in the area 24/7. The SNT is supervised by Inspector Hembry who leads on Neighbourhood Policing for Stratford District and Sgt Ebbs who also oversees neighbourhood Policing in the Shipston on Stour area. Alcester SNT currently consists of 2 Police officers and 4 Police Community Support Officers, and our contact details are shown above.

Incidents of a public interest from the last week: -

GREAT ALNE

- Suspicious Circumstances. Appleby Close. Male from a white van has gone to house and asked if car on the drive was for sale. His tone was quite stern, and the caller was concerned regards his motives. He eventually left with another male in the van. He was described as a black male wearing an orange hi-vis jacket. 3.40pm Saturday 22nd April. 0202 22/04/2023

BIDFORD

- Burglary. Public House, High Street. Entry has been gained to the property and money and alcohol has been stolen. Between 12.30am and 9.30am Sunday 23rd April. 0090 23/04/2023
- Burglary & Arson. Disused premises between the High Street and the roundabout. Entry gained to building and a fire started. Damage caused to windows and other areas of the building. At least six young persons' seen on the roof shortly before the fire was spotted. 7.20pm Friday 21st April. 0320 21/04/2023 Ongoing issue.
- Attempt Distraction Burglary. Wilkes Way. Male has gone to house and has asked occupant to follow him outside to look at damage to the roof, which he offered to repair. The occupant was concerned that this was just an attempt to distract him while someone else entered the property. The male left a leaflet which will be passed to police for further enquires to establish the legitimacy of the call. After receiving your call or a completed anonymous online form, Crimestoppers create a report that brings together all the information you gave us, making sure it doesn't contain any information that could identify you.

Your report is sent to the relevant authority with the legal responsibility to investigate crimes, make arrests and charge people in order to bring them to justice. This could be your local police force or an agency such as the UK Border Agency or HM Revenue & Customs
